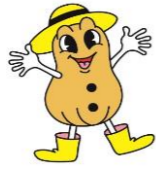







Bring the designated bag to the garbage collection site by 8:30. (Up to 5 bags at a time)

The designation bag	The collection day	Illustration
Burnable garbage (WHITE)	Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays	 <p>Please cut the branches in the garden to 50 cm. (30 centimeters in diameter tied with string)</p>
Non-burnable garbage (RED)	2nd,5th Thursdays	 <p>Glass, pottery bowl, plate, flowerpot Please bring items that do not fit in a bag to the Clean Center.</p>
Cans (GREEN)	1st,3rd,5th Tuesdays	 <p>Empty the spray can (make a hole)</p>
Glass bottles (YELLOW)	4th Tuesdays	 <p>Please separate bottle lids by type.</p>
Plastic containers and packaging (TRANSPARENCY)	1st,3rd,4th Thursdays	  <p>with a plastic mark</p>
PET bottles (BLUE)	2nd,4th Saturdays	  <p>Please remove the lid and label and put it in a bag</p>
Waste paper Newspapers, magazines and cardboard etc.	Twice a month on the area	 <p>Fold the cardboard and tie it with string Tie the books together with a string put the paper in a paper bag</p>
Metals Metals.Small electric goods.Hard plastic (VIOLET)	2nd Tuesdays	 <p>Please remove the batteries from small home appliances Please bring items that do not fit in a bag to the Clean Center.</p>
Dry batteries Fluorescent lights lighter (ORANGE)	Once a month on the area	 <p>Please put the battery in an orange bag or a transparent bag. Please bind the fluorescent lamp with a string. Remove the gas from the lighter and disassemble it.</p>
